

Hobson.C. & Walker J. & C. Fox-Hunting Atlas's and Maps

General Description-

The Hunting Maps are all sourced on a County Atlas under the title of 'The British Atlas...' which contained 47 maps including County and General maps for E & W, and separate maps for Wales. First issued in London by Longman, Rees, Orme, Brown & C^o, J & C Walker. issued 1837, although some maps carry dates for 1835, they are more or less to a standard size and layout, designed and engraved by the Walker Brothers, later also published by them, for more accurate measurements and details of a particular county read the currently available County Carto- bibliographies.

Sources and Descriptions for Hobson & Walker Fox-Hunting Atlas's-

In most cases the dating of the Hunting Atlas's is approximate and will vary from County to County as it is regularly based on railway and census information rather than a dated title page, bracketed dates below are therefore circa dates for those counties named within the brackets. The Hunting atlas's contain 42 county maps, which appeared in a mix of Portrait/Landscape layouts. In addition to the Atlas, hunting maps were also issued in a folding dissected form cased within hard red cloth covers with a gilt title 'Fox Hunting Map of' frequently these folding versions were in an intermediate state to the Atlas copies.

Approximate size and detail

Size-14.9" x 12" [.3"]

Title, Scale, Census and Reference information tend to be Upper R/L on most maps, with the Hunts outlined in mainly strong colour shades and named in dark blue uppercase letters, believed to be added in block stencil manner.

Any text in blue e.g. '[CAPT SPICER](#)' informs the reader of some form of change or amendment to the previous copy and might be an addition, deletion, or even a change of font from lower to uppercase or visa versa.

Folding Examples

Attention has been drawn to a possible conflict in the previous identifying numbering/letter system used, so, from March 2015 these will be amended so as not to conflict with the identifying system normally used in County Carto-Bibliographies, from this date all examples will now be identified by Map number and actual or approximate date, this will allow a flexible identity number in a chronological order that will not cause confusion when comparing a similar map

contained in a particular County Carto-bibliography, the normal chronological letter system used to signify the map is a Lithographic copy will be absent as **ALL** folding, dissected and cased examples of Hunting maps from this series are Lithographic **NOT** Intaglio prints.

Title, Scale, Census and Reference information tend to be Upper R/L on most maps, with the Hunts outlined in strong colour shades and named in dark blue uppercase letters. It is quite common for folding dissected examples to differ in small ways from Atlas copies issued around the same date.

Border- tTt outer line, dl inner graduated L/L. obbc-Pi 'Published by Longman, Rees, Orme & Brown & C° Paternoster Row, London. or 'Published by J & C Walker Castle St or Furnival Street. Holborn.' or variants of. In the 1890s a single example Middlesex carries a Pi for Letts & Son. Frequently but not always obar or obbr - a map number e.g. 'N° .3'

[N.B. Castle St was renamed Furnival St in 1885. but individual counties not all updated at one time.]

NB. In the Mid to late 1800s the Devon Hunts seemed to be in a constant state of flux.

MR. LEAMONS occupies the former space between Four Burrows in West Cornwall and the un hunted area before Mr. Marshall & Mr.Morgan later became Mr. Coryton's Hunt.

LORD PORTSMOUTH Hunt occupies Parts Nth Devon, Mr Furse, Eggesford & Tiverton Hunts.

SOUTH DEVON occupies the previously un Hunted area around Dartmoor additionally taking in the earlier Devon Hunt

NORTH DEVON as time progresses occupies a much reduced area to that initially shown on early Hobson maps, at that time [Devon had 10 Hunts] later this reduced to [8 Hunts].

MR TRELAWNEY The former Mr Roe Hunt has been absorbed into Mr Trelawnys.
