

EDWARD STANFORD & C^o HUNT MAPS

Based on the "Large Scale Map of England & Wales on 15 full & 3 half sheets 1815", issued 1816 & 1818 [BL K 5-74 England Tab 11 Maps STE(3), & Maps 148.d.25]. London. Aaron Arrowsmith 10, Soho Square.

Later obtained, amended and sold by Edward Stanford as both an untitled 'Atlas' [or Set of Maps lacking a t.p. in 24 sheets, 3miles/1"] and separate folding maps, both entitled - [Atlas] "Large Scale Railway and Station Map of England & Wales" May 1st 1876. **(Bart coll)**
The Folding Railway Map alternative form was on the other hand variously dated, May 1st 1876, January 1st 1877, February 1st 1878, March 1st 1884 indicating they were probably under continuous issue. The maps were generally uncoloured except for Place/Station names and depiction of the actual lines which were coloured in red.

Stanford also used them to produce a [standard] Hunt Map under a general title 'The Fox Hunts' from January 1st 1877 - March 1st 1884, sold folding/dissected and based on the actual numbered sheets 1- 24, They had a colour wash to delineate the different Hunts.

In addition to the 'The Fox Hunts' maps, Stanford also produced a series of named Hunt Maps, these latter 'Specials' were sold folding in a Red Leather casing with decorative borders and Single Hunt name in gold block these are exceedingly rare, they were centered on a particular Hunt e.g. ' LORD LEACONFIELD'S HUNT.' **(Bart coll)**, this particular map is a composite of sheets 21 and 22, again with a colour wash for each Hunt displayed. The price for these 'specials' varied from 5/- to 12s 6d each.
