APPENDIX 4.

FOLDING DISSECTED POCKET DESIGNS FOR O.S. MAPS.

In addition to the standard folding/dissected map there were three alternative forms of OS Hunt map in a practical pocket format available to Hunt Members, the earliest designed by Maj Ansell c1906, adopted and advertised by Edward Stanford is described in his 'A Resume.....1909' Catalogue and later a alternative in laminated form became available [post 1967] designed by Lt Col Turner see below. To save searching for the original writings they are repeated here.

"Major Ansell's Patent Method of Map Mounting."[c1900 or later]

'This is a new method of mounting devised and patented by Major Ansell. Half of the map is mounted on one side and half on the back, and it is arranged in such a convenient way that the continuation north and south (or east and west, as the case may be) can be at once picked up, without opening out the whole map.

The advantages of this system are:-

- (1) The map being mounted on both sides of the linen will occupy only half the space as under the ordinary system, and conversely a sheet of given size will contain twice as much map area.
- (2) The map is easy to open, and can be so arranged before starting on a journey that there may be very little opening out necessary, and the map can be read like a book.
- (3) The covers are so fixed as to protect the map when folded up.

It is difficult to give in words an adequate description of the advantages of this system, which must be seen and used to be fully appreciated. The method can be adopted for any maps, and should be specially suited for Motoring, Cycling, or Hunting, or whenever space is valuable.'

After reading the folding book/map illustrating the principles of compilation and use, it is easy to see its functionality out in the field whilst hunting, however in all the years of collecting I have come across few examples of a hunt using this method of production, and have come to suspect its costs failed to appeal to the user who probably at the time still used the earlier proven Maj Ansell c1900 form of OS hunt map in its compact pocket size and practical design even though not waterproof, many examples of this form of hunt map produced by Stanford & later by Sifton Praed still exist. Additionally a problem associated with this method of production is that the lamination prevents the uninitiated from identifying the physical joins between differing sheets, they are also for some reason subject to colour fade.

Bridges Patent Mounting System

Variously described as Bridges Patent Mounting or The Stanford-Bridges Patent Mounting [Patent N° /212 445/23]

This system or method of folding, mounting and presentation first appeared around 1919 and enjoyed a short lease of life, around 10 - 11 years, the latest example so far seems to be 1930, presumably the mounting evolved over time as there appears to be several variants, most of which seemed to require Mss marking by green/red coloured arrows to confirm/indicate where sections met, or the use of orange lines across the map from East to West. The system failed to attract a great many followers [individual maps were expensive by comparison with standard issues] and so not many have survived, only three Hunt map examples have been located to date. All examples viewed to date are confined to Popular Edition 1" or the 6" maps.

A complex system difficult to describe in a simple clear understandable form, as illustrated by the various descriptions given by Map Sellers on eBay-

"Appears to me to consist of repeating a section of map to save turning or opening a folded map!"

"..in the curious dissected and cloth mounted patent fold.."

"Each section is a folded panel enabling sections of the map to be turned north south, east west and vice versa. Red arrows are shown on the map where the individual sections meet..."

"An interesting form of mounting that allows the user to see individual areas without opening out the full map."

Ordnance Survey 6" to 1Mile SW London Stanford-Bridges Patent Mounting 1919 Edition Ordnance Survey Popular edition Sheet 73 (Rugby) 1920

Sellers description-

"Each section is a folded panel enabling sections of the map to be turned north south, east west and vice versa. Red arrows are shown on the map where the individual sections meet. These maps are scarce as they were four shillings and sixpence a sheet the most expensive fourth series maps at the time. Few of them exist in in good condition due to the unique way they were produced and a complete set is unknown of."

Ordnance Survey Popular Edition Sheets 72 & 82 with parts of 46 & 54 [c1923]

South Nottingham, and Haddon & Bicester Hunt Maps, with this system it is impossible to see more than 1/3 or less of these maps at any one time, against that you can view all of the printed surface in easy steps without opening the entire map on each occasion. If you are intimately acquainted with the locality to view a small area this way could be very useful, especially if you happen to be sitting on the back of your horse, conversely it could be disadvantageous in unfamiliar territory and perhaps this is one of the reasons it did not catch on with the hunting fraternity, another being the usually larger format, too large to fit in the coat pocket unlike the more conveniently sized Ansell fold double sided map.

APPENDIX 5. SWISS A.H. & SWISS C° COVER VARIATIONS

- '1st' Orange Boards** The printed text in black is of varied sizes Hollow & Bold uppercase throughout, the decorative element is a surround of curved double lines in solid black, containing a hollow uncoloured diamond pattern, with decorative light 'curling swirls' along the outer edges, This 1st Issue cover appeared on one map only and was then[see notes below] followed by 10 Basic Types, this can further be increased by printing type/font variations see notes below. The order below is not meant to be a chronological dating, although the Yellow covers with vignette illustrations appear to be the earliest to follow the 1st issue described above, but this only appears to apply to the countryside hunt maps, those early maps specifically related to Devon and part cross border hunts of E Cornwall & West Somerset are early issue maps and these have a 'standard' design cover type 'C' and probably pre-date the Yellow covers.
- 'A' Yellow Boards** - Vignette with 3 Huntsmen & 3 Hounds.
- 'B' Yellow Boards** - Vignette with 7 Huntsmen & 7 Hounds
- 'C' Red Boards** - 'HUNTING MAP.' with a upper/lower line 'choppy' wave pattern, as on 'NORTH DEVON..... West Somerset with upper/lower border of twin dls enclosing a 'chain' link & diamond pattern.
- 'D' Red Boards** - dl enclosing a repeated tiny 8 petal flower head, corner - is a unenclosed large '8 petal flower head'.
- 'E' Red Boards** - dl enclosing a repeated tiny 8 petal flower head, corner- half triangle & half 3 stemmed petal.
- 'F' Red Boards** - dl border enclosing a 'rounded oval enclosing a diamond', corner- half triangle & half 3 stemmed petal.
- 'G' Red Boards** - dl border enclosing a 'oval enclosing a diamond with a triangle interlink', corner- 'spear shape flower head'.
- 'H' Red Boards** - dl border enclosing a 'hollow swastika' design, corner - unenclosed '5 leaf stem'
[The Sanskrit style i.e. R hand turned angle of equilateral cross (卐) not its mirrored form which sometimes appears on statues of Buddha]
- 'I' Red Boards** - Tt dls with a heavy 'swirl' corner
- 'J' Red Boards** - dls with a repeating 'hollow 6 petal head' within, corner is a double 'Rose' with 'crossed stems' [X].
- 'K' Red Boards** - Thick outer with thin inner lines the corners are extended with a form of 'hook enclosed in a shadow surround', the only example seen was a 3rd Edition N° 7 map in a MCMus display cabinet.
